



TERMS & CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions apply to the following:

- H&B Junior;
- H&B Teen;
- H&B Family;
- Alive Outside Kids Camps; and
- Alive Outside Private / Team Building Events for Children.

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1. Parental/Guardian Declaration

By accepting these Terms & Conditions, I agree that Alive Outside is not liable for any personal injury or any other accident that may cause injury to me, my child(ren) or any of the children I am registering.

It is my responsibility to make sure other parents/guardians are fully aware of the risks associated with taking part, and to pass on any important information to them.

In case of injury or illness to me, my child(ren) or any of the children I am registering, I give my consent to emergency transportation and the administration of first aid and medical treatment.

2. Personal Accident Insurance Cover

As every participant has different insurance needs, it is the decision and responsibility of each parent/guardian to ensure their child is fully covered in accordance with their specific requirements when participating.

Alive Outside, the organisers of the event, strongly recommends that each parent/guardian has their own Personal Accident Cover in the unlikely event of their child getting injured.

3. Physical Condition of Participants

Alive Outside recommends that any parent who has health-related concerns about their child taking part in one of our events, visit their local GP for a health check-up before participating in the event to make sure that the event is appropriate for them. All participants do so at their own risk.

4. Infectious Diseases

All our events takes place in Killruddery Estate, a vast working farm, which is home to a wide variety of plants and animals, both domestic and wild.

Alive Outside encourages the parents/guardians of all participants to know the symptoms of Infectious Diseases, especially Weils / Leptospirosis Disease, which is an acute infectious disease spread by infected wild and domestic animals. If your child develop any symptoms, you should see a medical professional immediately.

By accepting these Terms & Conditions, you agree to the risks associated with your child running through the natural habitat of these plants and animals. Alive Outside does not accept liability for any illness contracted – everyone takes part at their own risk.

5. Refunds

A. Kids Camps

Your registration is secured upon completion of the online purchase. As this purchase is for a Kids Camp for a specific week, unfortunately you are not entitled to a refund in case your child cannot attend. You may though be able to transfer to another week, subject to availability – see 7a. Transfers/Switching Events below for more info.

Unfortunately, the €20 deposit to secure your place in the Camp is non-refundable.

B. HELL & BACK Main Event Weekends

Your registration is secured upon completion of the online purchase. As this purchase is for a specific HELL & BACK event on a specific date, unfortunately you are not entitled to a refund in case you or your child cannot attend. You may be

able though to transfer your registration to another person or move to another week/event (subject to availability) – see 6. Replacement Participants and 7. Transfers/Switching Events below for more info.

C. Private Event

For Private Events, please contact your Group Event Organiser. Each event will be dealt with in accordance with the original event agreement.

6. Replacement Participants (H&B Main Weekends Only)

If your child(ren) cannot take part in HELL & BACK, you can easily appoint a replacement to take your place, right up to race day. Here is what to do:

1. Email the parent of your child's replacement your original Ticket / Confirmation Email.
2. On the day, your child's replacement should present this Confirmation Email at the Registration Tent where a Marshal will make the name change.
3. The parent of your child's replacement must read the Event Terms and Conditions and, if happy with them, sign their name beside the allocated Wristband Number to collect the wristband.
4. So, if your child can no longer take part, you can allocate your place to someone else right up until the event day.

7A. Switching Kids Camp Weeks

Subject to availability, you may be able to switch your child's camp week by emailing info@aliveoutside.ie. Because many camps sell out in advance, the more time you can give us, the better chance we have of being able to accommodate you.

Unfortunately, if we are unable to accommodate your switch request, we will also be unable to refund your registration fee.

7B. Transfers / Switching Events (H&B Main Weekends Only)

As well as transferring your registration to another person, you have the option to switch event dates. Requests to do so must be made in writing to info@aliveoutside.ie within the following time frame:

- Up to 6 weeks (30 working days) of Event = Transfer Possible
- Within 6 weeks (30 working days) of Event = Transfer Not Possible

Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate a transfer after this time. Switching dates is subject to availability and can only be done for events where registration is live on our website.

If you are unable to transfer to another event, you may be able to find a replacement to take your place. See 6. Replacement Participants section above for full details.

8. Event Rescheduling Policy

Our events take place all year round and go ahead within the reasonable weather expectations of Ireland. As everyone is aware though, there is the potential for extreme or severe weather and therefore we have an Event Rescheduling Policy if the conditions are very bad.

Our aim is to do all we can to make your experience as enjoyable and safe as possible. If though we deem weather conditions to be potentially hazardous and unsafe for participants, we reserve the right to postpone and reschedule the event for an alternative date to maintain competitor safety.

Where possible, our policy is to postpone an event NO LATER THAN 9PM on the night beforehand and our decision about postponing an event is final.

A. Private / Team Building Events

In the case of a postponement, we will be in touch directly with the Group Leader and confirm cancellation no later than 9pm the night before the event.

You will then have the option of:

1. Switching your registration to the new reschedule date; or
2. Getting a full refund*.

B. HELL & BACK Main Event Weekends

In the case of a postponement, we will use all the media available to us to inform you as quickly as possible:

In the case of an event being postponed and rescheduled, you will have the option of:

1. Switching your registration to the new reschedule date; or
2. Getting a full refund*.

** To avail of a full refund, you must email info@aliveoutside.ie within **72 HOURS** of the rescheduled date being announced. Unfortunately we will be unable to offer you a refund if you do not contact us within this time.*

Please email info@aliveoutside.ie if you change your email or SMS details.

Alive Outside is not liable for any costs incurred by participants resulting from the postponement and rescheduling of an event, such as accommodation, transport etc.

9. Minimum Age Limit

Each child must be registered in the correct age group to participate. They must be of the correct age to participate on the day.

Our HELL & BACK events are not suitable for children aged 4 or younger. Alive Outside Kids Camps are not suitable for children aged 6 or younger.

10. H&B is not a Race, it's a Challenge!

HELL & BACK is a challenge rather than a race. The event is aimed at children from all sporting backgrounds and fitness levels. **Everyone** who finishes the course and makes it thru' Ireland's Toughest Physical & Mental Endurance Challenge for Kids is special in our eyes – not just the fastest! Therefore, we do not put any emphasis on the times children complete the course in.

Each child's focus should be on completing the course and doing their best but they should also be prepared to help their fellow participants throughout the route. Without a competitive element, this better encapsulates the ethos of what our event is about - focusing more on teamwork and helping each other, raising money for charity etc.

Your child's time, and who finishes first, is completely irrelevant to us but there will be a clock at the Start and Finish Lines showing the time of the day, so any parent who is interested in their child's time can calculate it themselves.

Placing more of an emphasis on helping fellow HellRaisers and camaraderie makes HELL & BACK a much better event for everyone and improves the experience of all our participants.

11. Optional Additional Costs (H&B Main Weekends Only)

When you register a child for a HELL & BACK Event, the fee includes their entry into the event and an exclusive Finisher's Gift.

Unless otherwise stated, the following services are not included in the price but may be available for purchase separately:

- Car Parking
- Return Shuttle Bus to/from Bray DART Station
- H&B Merchandising

We advise participants and spectators to wear appropriate footwear and clothing for HELL & BACK, taking into consideration the time of year, weather forecast and course terrain.

It is the responsibility of each participant to complete the event within the rules and regulations stated by Alive Outside. Anyone breaching these rules and regulations may be removed from the event without refund.

Alive Outside is an Irish company and its primary currency is Euros. We comply fully with Distance Selling Regulations. Our Terms & Conditions do not affect your statutory rights.

14. Privacy Policy

Alive Outside is committed to protecting your privacy. We will only use the information that we collect about you lawfully, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR 2018.

This privacy statement explains policies on data collection and use practices of the HELL & BACK website, hosted by Jalmia Solutions for Alive Outside. This statement applies only to the information collected online and does not apply to other offline Alive Outside sites, products or services.

Our website contains links to other sites not controlled or operated by us. We are not responsible for the privacy policies of websites that we do not control or operate. By accessing this website, you are consenting to the information collection and use practices described in this privacy statement.

Data Controller

"Alive Outside" (referred to as "we", "us", "our" or "Alive Outside" in this policy) refers to the sports events group Alive Outside, made up of Hell & Back, Tag Rugby, Summer Camps, School Tours and Corporate Events. Alive Outside is the "data controller" of all personal information that is collected and used about Alive Outside customers for the purposes of the Irish Data Protection Act 2018. Alive Outside Limited is registered in Ireland with registration number 480763 and registered offices at 22 Old Fort Road, Kevinsfort, Sligo.

Website Policy

1. Information

All information provided on our website is supplied in good faith. We endeavour to display the most up-to-date and accurate information and will happily correct any mistakes made. We cannot though be held responsible for any errors or omissions in details provided online.

2. Credit Card Security

Using a credit card to make purchases via our website is a secure way to pay for your items. We have put a number of security steps in place to give you, the customer, total confidence when purchasing your items via our website. Your credit card information is only supplied to our Credit Card processing company at the relevant stage of the payment process. We do not retain any records of credit card information on our web servers.

3. Pricing

All items purchased will be charged in Euro (Ireland) or Sterling (UK). For an exact conversion rate for your currency, please contact your bank or credit card provider.

4. Articles and website content

Collection of Information

1. Navigational Information

We gather navigational information about where visitors go on our website. This information allows us to see which areas are most visited and helps us improve the quality of your online experience by recognising and delivering more of the most desired features and services.

2. Technical Information

Technical details in connection with visits to this website are logged by our internet service provider for statistical purposes. No information is collected that could be used by us to identify website visitors unless required to do so by rule of law.

4. Personal Information

When registering for an Alive Outside event, you will be asked to provide your email address and mobile phone number. This information allows us to contact you with detailed information about the event you have registered for, including in case of a cancellation. These communications are not made for marketing purposes and cannot be opted-out of.

We will not send you any unsolicited marketing. We will only send you emails or other marketing messages where you have signed up to receive these. Marketing emails you have signed up to will also tell you how you can unsubscribe should you decide that you no longer wish to receive them. Please note that event participants will receive important

operational information about the event they have signed up for. As an event participant, this is not spam.

We will also use your contact details to keep you informed via email and/or SMS about Alive Outside events, news and offers that we think will be of interest to you. We will always give you the chance to unsubscribe should you choose to do so. At the bottom of every marketing email / SMS, there will always be an "unsubscribe" button.

We do not make the contact details of our database available to other unaffiliated companies for their marketing purposes, unless specific consent for such transfer to third party affiliates has been received from the user.

Any personal information we hold will be held securely and in accordance with our internal security policy and the law.

- Conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Alive Outside.
- Protect and defend the rights or property of Alive Outside.
- Act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of Alive Outside employees or agents, users of Alive Outside products or services, or members of the public.

Please be aware that we may use third party contractors to help provide services to you, such as fulfilling orders, processing payments, monitoring site activity, serving site content, organising information, conducting surveys, administering ezine and SMS campaigns, organising competitions etc. Outside contractors who have access to personal data are required to treat the information in a confidential manner.

7. Retention of Personal Data

In broad terms, we will not retain your data for longer than is necessary to fulfil the purpose it is being processed for. To determine the appropriate retention period, we consider the amount, nature and sensitivity of the personal data, the purposes for which we process it and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means.

We must also consider periods for which we might need to retain personal data in order to meet our legal obligations or to deal with complaints, queries and to protect our legal rights in the event of a claim being made.

When we no longer need your personal data, we will securely delete or destroy it.

Access to Your Information

If you would like to know what personal information Alive Outside holds about you, you may make a request to Alive Outside for copies of this information. You should be aware that we will need to see proof of identity before processing any such request (known as a 'subject access request') and may charge an administration fee of up to €10 to cover our costs in providing you with this information.

Security of Your Personal Information

Alive Outside strictly protects the security of your personal information and honours your choices for its intended use. We carefully protect your data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access or disclosure, alteration or destruction. As explained above, your personal information is never shared outside the company. Inside the company, data is stored on password-controlled servers only accessible to co-workers who need it to carry out their job responsibilities.

Customers also have a significant role in protecting their information. No unauthorised person can see or edit your information without knowing your team/group login (username and password), so do not share these with others.

8. Site Security

Alive Outside has a committed Security Policy. We retain the information you provide when registering on our website for any event but implement a number of sophisticated security measures to ensure the safety of this personal information. The information is contained on a secure server, which is accessible only by a limited number of employees who have authorised access rights to such information.

All sensitive and credit / debit card information supplied by any customer in the process of payment is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology. SSL is commonly used for managing the security of message transmission on the Internet through public-and-private key encryption and a digital certificate that establishes your credentials when doing Internet business or other on-line transactions. When you are asked to enter any personal details or credit card information, the website will be secure. This is easily identifiable by a green lock icon in the Page Address URL. SSL ensures that the information being transmitted to Alive Outside is secure.

If your browser supports SSL, and if you entered our site via our secure server access, then transmission of any sensitive data will be protected. If your browser does not support SSL, we recommend that you upgrade to the latest version of any browser to enhance the security of further transactions - otherwise the transmission of your personal data may not be protected and Alive Outside disclaims any responsibility in this case.

As the Alive Outside website expands, improves and updates, we reserve the right to modify or amend the policy at any time and for any reason. When policy changes occur, Alive Outside will automatically update the Terms & Conditions with the new details.
