1. Individual Participant Declaration

By accepting these Terms & Conditions, I agree that Alive Outside is not liable for any personal injury or any other accident that may cause injury to me.

In case of injury or illness, I give my consent to emergency transportation and the administration of first aid and medical treatment.

2. Team Leader Declaration

I acknowledge, that as Team Leader, I am accepting these Terms & Conditions on behalf of my team mates.

It is my responsibility as Team Leader to make my team mates fully aware of the risks associated with taking part, and to pass on any important information from Alive Outside about HELL & BACK to them.

I agree that Alive Outside is not liable for any personal injury or any other accident that may cause injury to me or my team mates.

In case of injury or illness to me or any of my team mates, I give my consent to emergency transportation and the administration of first aid and medical treatment.

3. Group Manager Declaration

I acknowledge, that as Group Manager, I am accepting these Terms & Conditions on behalf of all the participants in my group.

It is my responsibility as Group Manager to make all the participants in my group fully aware of the risks associated with taking part, and to pass on any important information from Alive Outside about HELL & BACK to them.

I agree that Alive Outside is not liable for any personal injury or any other accident that may cause injury to me or any participant in my group.

In case of injury or illness to me or any of the participants in my group, I give consent to emergency transportation and the administration of first aid and medical treatment.

4. Personal Accident Insurance Cover

A €6 per person Personal Accident Insurance Fee is a mandatory part of your registration, as it covers injuries you may sustain taking part in HELL & BACK.

HELL & BACK is Ireland's Toughest Mental & Physical Endurance Challenge and there are risks associated when participating. This Personal Accident Policy, which is underwritten by AIG Ireland, provides various benefits, including €1,500 Medical Expenses per person for injuries sustained while participating in the HELL & BACK Event you have registered for. Please note that Loss of Income is not covered.

This is a very brief synopsis of the cover provided and does not form the basis of your contract with AIG. For a full synopsis of the cover provided or if you have queries, please contact our Head Office on info@aliveoutside.ie or 01 2147355.

5. Physical Condition of Participants

Before taking part in HELL & BACK, Alive Outside recommends that you contact a medical professional to make sure that it is appropriate for you. We strongly recommend that all participants with health-related concerns visit their local GP for a health check-up before participating.

All participants in HELL & BACK events do so at their own risk.

Alive Outside urges Team Leaders and Group Managers to instruct their members to seek appropriate medical advice prior to signing up or participating in a HELL & BACK event.

6. Infectious Diseases

HELL & BACK venues are often large working farms, which are home to a wide variety of plants and animals, both domestic and wild. As the course involves running through ponds and rivers and other natural terrain, Alive Outside encourages HELL & BACK participants to know the symptoms of Infectious Diseases, especially Weils / Leptospirosis Disease. This is an acute, infectious disease spread by infected wild and domestic animals. If you develop any symptoms after the event you should see a medical professional immediately.

By accepting these Terms & Conditions, you agree to the risks associated with running through the natural habitat of these plants and animals. Alive Outside does not accept liability for any illness contracted – everyone takes part at their own risk.

7. Refunds

Your registration is secured upon completion of the online purchase. Applications for a refund must be made in writing to info@aliveoutside.ie within the following time frame:

- Up to 6 weeks (30 working days) before Event = **50%** of Registration Fee
- Within 6 weeks (30 working days) of Event = **0%** of Registration Fee

We regret that you are not entitled to a refund if you pull out within 6 weeks of the event, as we will have your t-shirt ordered & delivered, number assigned, Goody Bag etc - so many of the costs associated with your participation will already have been incurred.

Partial Refunds for Teams

If you are part of a Team, we are unable to issue you a partial refund if one member of your team cannot take part. In this case, you have two options:

1. Recruit a replacement to take the spot of the person who cannot take part - see Replacement Participant section below.
2. We can refund you for the entire team (within the same Refund parameters stated above) - and the rest of you can instead decide to take part in a future HELL & BACK event together.

8. Replacement Participants

If you or a team mate cannot take part in HELL & BACK, you can easily appoint a replacement to take your place, right up to race day. Here is what to do:

1. Email your replacement your original Ticket / Confirmation Email.
2. On the day, your replacement should present this Confirmation Email to one of our marshals at the Registration Tent and collect your allocated Wristband on your behalf.
3. Your replacement must read the Event Terms and Conditions and, if happy with them, print & sign their name beside the allocated Wristband Number - and draw a line through your name, indicating you are no longer participating.
4. So if you get injured and can no longer take part, you can allocate your place to someone else right up until the event day.

9. Transfers / Switching Events

Applications to:

- transfer your registration to another person; or
- switch event dates

must be made in writing to info@aliveoutside.ie within the following time frame:

- Up to 6 weeks (30 working days) of Event = Transfer Possible
- Within 6 weeks (30 working days) of Event = Transfer Not Possible

Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate a transfer after this time. Switching dates is subject to availability and can only be done for events where registration is live on our website.

If you are unable to transfer to another event, you may be able to find a replacement to take your place. See 8. Replacement Participants section above for full details.

10. Event Rescheduling Policy

HELL & BACK events take place all year round and go ahead within the reasonable weather expectations of Ireland. As everyone is aware though, there is the potential for extreme or severe weather and therefore we have an Event Rescheduling Policy if the conditions are very bad.

Our aim is to do all we can to make your experience at HELL & BACK as enjoyable and safe as possible. If though we deem weather conditions to be potentially hazardous and unsafe for participants, we reserve the right to postpone and reschedule the event for an alternative date to maintain competitor safety.

Where possible, our policy is to postpone an event NO LATER THAN 9PM on the night beforehand and our decision about postponing an event is final.

In the case of a postponement, we will use all the media available to us to inform you as quickly as possible:

In the case of an event being postponed and rescheduled, you will have the option of:

1. Switching your registration to the new reschedule date; or
2. Getting a full refund*.

** To avail of a full refund, you must email info@aliveoutside.ie within **72 HOURS** of the rescheduled date being announced. Unfortunately we will be unable to offer you a refund if you do not contact us within this time.*

Alive Outside is not liable for any costs incurred by participants resulting from the postponement and rescheduling of an event, such as accommodation, transport etc.

11. Under 18's

HELL & BACK is not suitable for children aged 15 or younger.

For participants aged 16 or 17, please note that they are not covered by insurance unless we have received a completed Parental/Guardian consent form. To get an Under 18s Parental Consent Form, please contact our Head Office on info@aliveoutside.ie or 01 2147355.

It is mandatory for all participants aged 16 and 17 to bring valid photo ID with them on the day to ensure they can gain access to the course. Alive Outside reserve the right to refuse admission if a Parental/Guardian consent form and valid photo ID are not provided at registration.

12. Under 23's

For insurance purposes, anyone who looks 23 years or younger may be asked to present valid photo ID at Registration. Alive Outside reserves the right to refuse admission should valid photo ID not be presented when requested.

13. Timing Chips

HELL & BACK is a challenge rather than a race.

The event is aimed at everyone from all sporting backgrounds and ages, from 16 year old schoolkids to 70+ year old grandparents. **Everyone** who finishes the course and makes it thru' Ireland's Toughest Physical & Mental Endurance Challenge is special in our eyes – not just the fastest. Therefore, we do not put any emphasis on the times people complete the course in.

Your primary focus should be on completing the course, helping your fellow participants through and doing your best. Without a competitive element, we feel this will better encapsulate the ethos of what our event is about - focusing more on camaraderie and helping each other, raising money for charity etc.

Your time, and who finishes first, is completely irrelevant to us but there will be a clock at the Start and Finish Lines showing the time of the day, so anyone who is interested in their times can calculate it themselves.

Placing more of an emphasis on helping fellow HellRaisers and camaraderie makes HELL & BACK a much better event for everyone and improve the experience of all our participants.

14. Optional Additional Costs

When you register for a HELL & BACK Event, the fee includes your entry into the event, mandatory Personal Accident Insurance Cover and exclusive Finisher's Tshirt.

Unless otherwise stated, the following services are not included in the price but can be purchased separately:

- Car Parking
- Return DART Shuttle Bus (Bray only)
- Start in 1st Wave of the Day

15. Photo Gallery & Image Rights

By taking part in HELL & BACK, and by accepting these Terms & Conditions, you grant Alive Outside the absolute right and permission to copyright and use, re-use, and publish, photographic portraits or pictures of you or in which you may be included, in whole or in part, or composite or distorted in character or form, without restriction as to changes or alterations from time to time, in conjunction with your own or a fictitious name, or reproductions thereof in colour or otherwise, made through any medium, and in any and all media now or hereafter known, for art, advertising, trade or any other legal purpose. You also consent to the use of any printed matter in conjunction therewith.

It is the responsibility of each participant to complete HELL & BACK within the rules and regulations stated by Alive Outside. Anyone breaching these rules and regulations may be removed from the event without refund.

Alive Outside is an Irish company and its primary currency is Euros. We comply fully with Distance Selling Regulations. Our Terms & Conditions do not affect your statutory rights.

17. Privacy Policy

Alive Outside is committed to protecting your privacy. We will only use the information that we collect about you lawfully, in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

We are committed to protecting the privacy of users of the HELL & BACK website and are aware that, as a user, you care about the security and privacy of your information.

When you are asked to enter any personal details or credit card information, the website will be secure. This is easily identifiable by a green lock icon in the Page Address URL. SSL ensures that the information being transmitted to Alive Outside is secure.
